# **New Curriculum for Rehabilitation Medicine Advanced Training**

The College (RACP) is renewing the Basic and Advanced Training curricula. The new curricula will place an enhanced focus on competency-based training, supported by programmatic assessment approaches and provide clear learning goals and progression criteria against which trainees will be assessed

## What is the 2024 curriculum transition year?

First year trainees who started Rehabilitation Medicine Advanced Training in 2024 are enrolled under the new curriculum. Transitional arrangements have been in place for the 2024 clinical training year, with trainees using the new curriculum standards and current work-based assessments outlined in the 2024 new curriculum handbook.

### What changes are coming in 2025?

From 2025, first year trainees who start Rehabilitation Medicine Advanced Training in 2025, and continuing trainees who started in 2024, will follow the new curriculum. Trainees will use the College's new Training Management Platform to apply for training and complete different learning and assessment tools.

Trainees who entered into the Rehabilitation Medicine Advanced Training program before 2024 will continue to follow the PREP program requirements.

#### What's next?

The College is investing in a new Training Management Platform (TMP) to provide an online interface supporting use of the new curricula, including new learning and assessment tools. It is scheduled to be available for registrations for the 2025 clinical year opening in early December 2024.

We're developing training and support resources to help you understand the changes to the curricula and navigate the new TMP technology features. We'll share these with trainees and educators as they are available.
