

# Education Governance Review Implementation: Planning Sessions Summary Report (August-September 2024)

Purpose:	To inform the Rehabilitation Medicine Society of Australia and New Zealand of the outcomes of the Education Governance Review Implementation planning sessions held from August to September 2024.
Synopsis:	<p>On 21 June 2024, <a href="#">the RACP Board approved the new education governance structure</a> to progress to implementation. ~21 planning sessions were arranged with key stakeholders (members and staff) to seek feedback on the implementation process, draft timeline and appropriate stakeholder engagement mechanisms. Approximately 44 Fellows and 124 staff were in attendance. Key risks, concerns and considerations were also discussed to inform change management and transition.</p> <p>A summary report outlining the outcomes of these planning sessions, and the confirmed implementation timeline is provided as attachment 1. There was broad member and staff support for the proposed implementation timeline and sequence with a range of helpful feedback and suggestions about key considerations, concerns and engagement strategies to inform the next steps.</p> <p>The implementation project has now formally commenced with development activities. Committee input will be sought from early 2025 on draft implementation products including terms of reference and individual committee transition plans, etc. Education and training committee operations continue as per usual otherwise.</p>
